WHY WE CHARGE FEES:



Delaware State Parks are **70%** self-funded. Camping and entrance fees make up the largest part of that funding.



It takes year-round maintenance to keep cross country courses ready for fall events.



Cross country practices and meets require staff overtime and additional maintenance during the fall season. We keep bathrooms clean, pick up trash, maintain trails, stripe fields for parking, extend office hours, and put on extra staff to ensure everyone's safety at the meets.

WHAT WE CHARGE:

Entrance Fees:



\$4 per Delaware-registered vehicle **\$8** per out-of-state registered vehicle

School Fees:



For meets with four or more participating schools, \$60 per school to cover rental and administrative



There is no charge for runners, staff, or volunteers that come to the park in a marked school vehicle.



Dual and tri-meets are free.
