TIPS TO ENHANCE YOUR VISIT

Pack a lunch. Only light snacks are available for purchase on the island, but there is a picnic area outside of the fort. We are a Carry In -Carry Out park. Please take all trash off the island with you.

Bring a water bottle. A water cooler is available on the island. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.

Be prepared to walk over uneven surfaces. Closed-toed shoes are recommended. The ground floor of the fort is handicap accessible, but the upper floors are not. Please notify ticket office staff if assistance will be needed.

Bring bug spray and sunscreen. Areas of Fort Delaware are in direct sunlight with little shade cover, and the marshy environment can lead to bugs. Packing a light jacket is also recommended in case of bad weather.

Arrive early. Tickets must be purchased at least 5 minutes before the ferry departs. Parking may be up to a 5 minute walk away.

Service dogs are welcome at Fort Delaware. Please leave other pets at home.

EXPERIENCE THE PARK

Fort Delaware

Built in 1859, Fort Delaware served as a Civil War prison which held roughly 33,000 Confederate prisoners of war.

Today, costumed interpreters transport visitors back in time to 1864. Hear stories of great escapes, tour the prisoner barracks and blacksmith shop, and experience the power of the Columbiad cannon firing a real gunpowder charge.



Pea Patch Island Nature Preserve

Home to one of the largest Atlantic Coast nesting sites for herons, egrets, and ibises north of Florida. An estimated 5,000 – 12,000 breeding pairs call this heronry home annually. Prime bird watching awaits from our heronry observation platform on the Prison Camp trail.
