The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control and the Department of Health and Social Services have teamed up to create opportunities for every person and family in Delaware to enjoy their state parks.

A park entrance fee is charged daily from March 1 through November 30. If you currently receive assistance from a State Service Center, you may be eligible to purchase an annual state park pass for \$10. This pass, which is placed on your vehicle's windshield, allows the vehicle and up to six occupants unlimited entry to the parks during the fee season.*

- Child Care Assistance Program



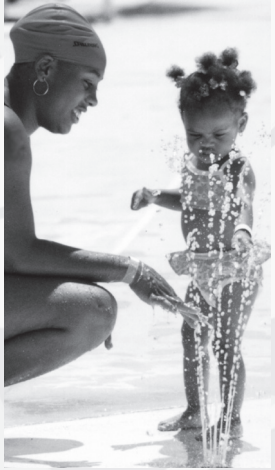
