Trail Description

Sea Hawk Trail

This flat, 1.5 mile loop trail meanders through mixed hardwood and conifer forest, crosses grassy meadow, and follows a section of the Indian River shoreline. Birding and wildlife viewing opportunities exist for nature enthusiasts as they experience the different coastal bays environment along the trail.

Seahorse Trail

The Seahorse Trail provides access to the western portion of the park. The trail travels over packed earth along forest edge, open meadow, and dense forest. Two connector trails join the Seahorse with the Sea Hawk Trail.
