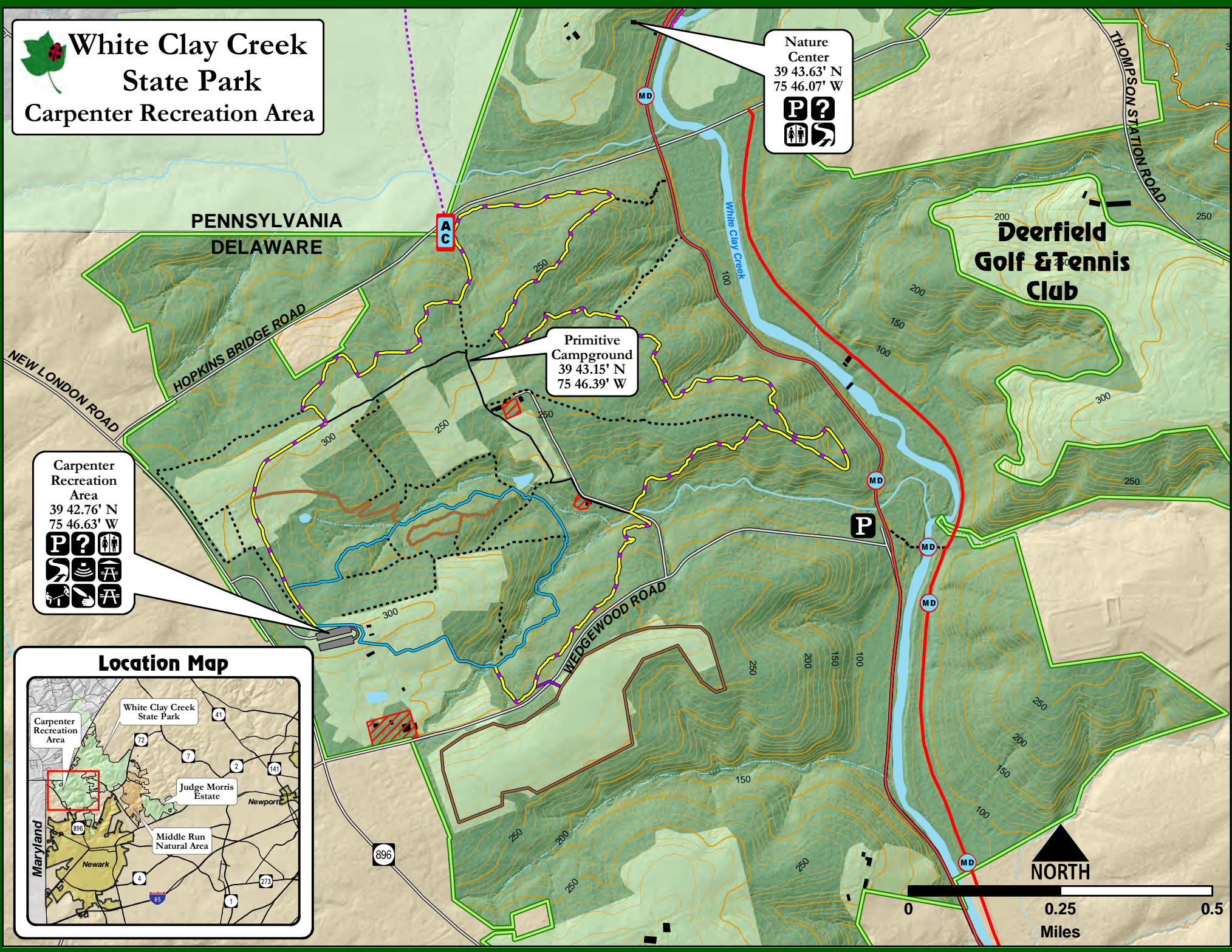
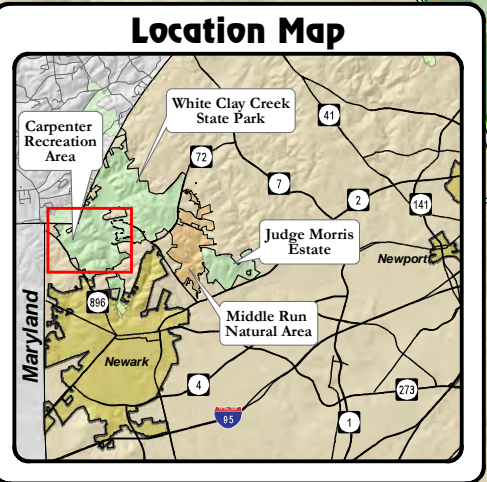

Trail Descriptions

Millstone Trail

Trail Width	Surface Type	Trail Grade	Accessible
Avg 4 Feet Min 1 Feet	Packed Earth Grass	Avg 7% Max 26%	- No

The Millstone Trail begins at the Carpenter Recreation Area and follows an easy to moderate contour over grass and packed earth. The trail traverses a boardwalk at Millstone Pond below a geological feature of rock outcroppings.

Twin Valley Trail

Trail Width	Surface Type	Trail Grade	Accessible
Avg 4 Feet Min 1 Feet	Packed Earth Grass	Avg 7% Max 24%	- No

The Twin Valley Trail meanders through mature beech, maple, and tulip forests on a moderate grade. The trail passes the Arc Corner Monument and an old foundation and cellar hole, while providing an excellent path to experience this area of White Clay Creek State Park.

Whitely Farms Trail

Trail Width	Surface Type	Trail Grade	Accessible
Avg 2 Feet Min 1 Feet	Crushed Stone Packed Earth	Avg 5% Max 22%	- No

The trail begins at the Nine Foot Road parking area near the old Whitely Farms. This single-track loop has a packed earth surface that passes through hayfields and forest of mature hardwoods. The grade is moderate throughout with a rapid descent near the connector for the David English Trail. The Whitely Farms Trail can also be accessed by a connector trail near the Possum Hill Parking Area. For a shorter trail experience, a double-track cut-off trail runs between Possum Hill and Hopkins Road.
