First State Heritage Park hosts the Colonial Market Fair on The Green with special agreements from the City of Dover and First State National Historical Park. The intent of this program is to recreate the sights and sounds of the 18<sup>th</sup> century, bringing the past to life for the visiting public.

For 2024, Dover's Colonial Market Fair will be held on Friday Evening (3:00 PM-8:00 PM) and Saturday (10:00-3:00), October 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>, with Friday being a "Tavern Night" theme.

Foremost, Market Fair is a public program with an educational mission. Public admission is kept free to ensure community accessibility. With limited space available in our historic venue – a genuine colonial square where markets were held weekly on Wednesdays and Saturdays – preference is given to participants who demonstrate a commitment to historical authenticity and offer meaningful interpretation, interactivity, or demonstrations of their trade or skill.

Applicants that will be selling goods at the 18<sup>th</sup> Century Market Fair are subject to a <u>non-refundable</u> \$75 vendor fee, to be paid via check upon application approval.

Participants further acknowledge that First State Heritage Park may photograph, quote, or in other ways document the artisans and their representatives, products, and display, for use by the site.
