2. Upon receipt of your application, your application will be reviewed and approved/denied by the Park.
3. If approved, we will process your reservation and you will be notified for payment.

Cancellation Policy

Your group may cancel its reservation or make changes of nights or attendees, by notifying the Campground Manager **in writing by email two weeks prior** to your scheduled date of arrival. If you fail to cancel or make changes to group size/number of nights **in writing prior to the two-week deadline**, your group will be charged the full cost of the reservation. **You are required to contact the Campground Manager in the event of any changes to original application.**
